The Susquehanna Area Regional Airport Authority (SARAA) is requesting statements of qualifications to provide professional control systems engineering design and construction administration services in support of the project to upgrade the control portion of the Airport's Baggage Handling System at Harrisburg International Airport located in Middletown, Pennsylvania. The awarded contract will be for the duration of the project.

The scope of work is generally described as providing engineering design services to prepare plans, specifications and bid documents for the upgrade of the control system associated with the Airport's Baggage Handling System (BHS). The scope of work will also include providing construction administration services to include resident representation during the period of construction when the successful bidder is actually upgrading the BHS system.
